



Seesaw Agreement

Your child will be using Seesaw while enrolled at Siena to document their learning, achievements and activities in the class and school in a digital format. This will be showcased in the form of photos, videos, drawings and notes. On some occasions, photos and videos may include your child and other students in their classrooms. Your child will work collaboratively with other students and show their work together and other times there could be group photos or videos of excursions and performances. We recognise as a parent/guardian, you are proud of you child's achievements, however, **we need you to refrain from placing any documents from Seesaw on any type of social media, eg. facebook, instagram, etc, to align with our Child Safe Policies.**

As this digital journal is used in a real time, authentic learning space, in some occasions there may be voices and other students/staff walking in the background of your child's work. This cannot always be helped, and we need your assistance in being patient.

Teachers, students and parents/guardians need to be aware comments and voice comments can be seen and heard by others. So we need to make sure all comments and voice comments are expressed in a positive manner. If people are using Seesaw negatively, they will be removed from the Seesaw community.

When students are adding posts to Seesaw, they could accidentally add posts to the wrong student's name. As teachers we monitor and approve posts to make sure it is the correct student's work. If students are found adding posts to the wrong students on purpose, and without teacher permission, the student may lose access to Seesaw and parents/guardians will be notified.



Seesaw is an amazing app that we will be using this year in our class as a way for your child to share what they are learning at school with you! Seesaw provides a safe and creative way for your child to document their skills in a moderated environment. We will use Seesaw to reflect and grow in all areas of study. We expect that the students will be excited to show you the great things we will be learning in the classroom.

Each child will have their own digital journal to which they will add photos, videos, drawings, and notes to showcase their learning. You only have access to your own child's work and all of the content is stored securely. 1. We need your help to successfully use Seesaw by:
 - Commenting,
 - Liking,
 - Leaving Voice Comments, on your child's learning, your child will love showing you their work and achievements in a positive way.
2. Talk to your child at night about the fantastic things you have seen on their Seesaw page.
3. Don't forget: In a group or 'everyone' post, please remember your comment is shared with everyone tagged - students and their parents. This is a great opportunity to encourage and recognise the whole class/group's achievements.
